

Higher Education Management and Planning

Start Date of the Program at Khatam University: 2016

Program Objective:

The Master's program in Higher Education Management and Planning focuses on developing the ability to identify the strengths and weaknesses of an educational system, becoming familiar with management models in universities, and analyzing them. It emphasizes the ability to design and develop educational and research programs in universities and higher education institutions, analyzing higher education programs within the framework of macro development plans, and developing skills to propose research projects in the field of higher education management and planning.

Program Duration:

The Master's program consists of courses offered over four semesters (two years). Three semesters are dedicated to coursework, while one semester is allocated for the completion of the thesis. The total number of credit hours required for graduation is 32, including 4 credit hours for the thesis, as per the curriculum approved by the Ministry of Science, Research, and Technology and implemented in universities.
